group, a Heart Foundation registered walking group, is 'hitting the streets' in July after 3 months off. The Foundation has stated that walks may recommence after 20th June. Knox SOW walk twice a month on the 1st & 3rd Fridays in teams of 2 to 5 people and will be restricting numbers to 20 walkers maximum. Their walks in July will be in the streets around Milpera Reserve, Wantirna. Check their website for the exact Start/Finish Location. You will need to contact Walk Organiser, David, if you are coming. 'First timers' receive training from Glenys and will be put in a team of experienced orienteers.

So, what have David and Glenys been doing for the last 3 'lockdown' months?

- 1) Walking around the areas selected for the next 6 walks, collecting clues and setting courses.
- 2) Being interviewed on Radio Eastern 98.1 FM about their Virtual Orienteering (as a result of their report in the RLCN May edition).
- 3) Organising Virtual Orienteering on their website (www.knox.org.au).

Many people (6 visitors per day!) have been 'letting their fingers do the walking' by using Google Maps Street View to 'walk' around Knox and other locations. (There are over 35 maps on their Maps webpage if you want to give it a go.) They received an email from Arco Di Carta, an orienteering group in Genoa, Italy, with the answers to the clues on a course that David set on Maui in Hawaii in 2015!
