Knox Street Orienteering Walkers (Knox SOW) has expanded and is now running walks twice a month on the 1st and 3rd Fridays at 10.30am. The group explores places in and around Knox and walks for one hour, finding answers to 20 clues shown on a map. In July, the group explored the Lewis Road area on the border of Wantirna South and Boronia. One of the clues was The Big Slide in Roselyn Crescent Reserve.
