The highlight of the May walks was the beautiful mural (Clue 20) on the side wall of the old squash courts and milkbar on the corner of McMahons Road and Loretto Avenue. It was painted by Lukey Soma. Walk Organiser, David, remembers playing squash at 'Paul Vear's' as these courts were known in the 1980s!

East of Commercial Road in Yose Street, the walkers discovered an old sign (Clue 17) on the side of the Oaklands Industries factory with an old phone number – FTG 303. How many years ago did we have letters in our phone numbers?

(Clue 12) was near a huge water storage tank in the Burke Road Reserve. It is evidently known as the Knox Reservoir. It must hold over 20 megalitres. They also found an elephant sitting on a letterbox (Clue 14) in Meagher Road!
